- Any intervener in support of the plaintiff file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages by 4:00 pm on 22 November 2021.
- 7. The defendants file and serve written submissions of no more than 30 pages by 4:00 pm on 10 December 2021.

8. Any intervener in support of the defendants, and any intervener who does not s103/2021 intervene in support of any party, file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages by 4:00 pm on 20 December 2021.
