

Date	Event	Appeal Book Reference
4 January 2013	Emergency services officers attend to house fire at appellant's premises. Deceased taken by ambulance to hospital.	
14 January 2013	Death of the deceased.	
18 November 2014	Appellant arraigned in Supreme Court before Hamill J and a jury of twelve on one count of manufacturing a large commercial quantity of methylamphetamine, one count of murdering the deceased and an alternative charge of unlawfully killing him. There were additional charges relating to cash and firearms seized from property with which she was connected.	
27 November 2014	Crown case closed and defence application made for directed verdicts of not guilty to homicide charges.	
28 November 2014	Further argument on directed verdict application.	
2 December 2014	Judgment delivered by Hamill J indicating decision to direct verdicts of not guilty to homicide charges.	
3 December 2014	Directed verdicts returned by jury.	
9 December 2014	Guilty verdicts returned by jury to remaining counts

11 December 2014	Appellant sentenced by Hamill J to aggregate 7½ years imprisonment (non-parole period) commencing on 2 December 2013 and expiring on 1 June 2021, with a balance of term of 4 years commencing on 2 June 2021 and expiring on 1 June 2025.	
19 December 2014	Notice of Appeal filed by Crown against acquittals of jury as directed by Hamill J.	
20 July 2015	Amended Notice of Appeal filed by Crown.	
26 August 2015	Hearing in the NSW Court of Criminal Appeal.	
8 April 2016	Decision of the NSW Court of Criminal Appeal handed down.	
5 May 2016	The appellant applied for special leave to appeal from the judgment of the Court of Criminal Appeal.	
16 November 2016	Special leave to appeal against the decision of the Court of Criminal Appeal was granted by Gageler and Nettle JJ.
